




12th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - C



Jesus asks us: Who am I for you? – a question answerable only after familiarity with Jesus in prayer, much as Jesus asks the disciples after his own powerful conversation with the Father. Then they are most able to recognize their master’s identity, and Peter confesses Jesus to be the Messiah. They are told to keep this secret as Jesus speaks openly about a harder truth, that he must suffer as

the scriptures have foretold. Jesus’ followers too must be willing to die to themselves every day in imitation of their savior. The first reading prophesies, for those who contemplate the death of God’s anointed one, a change of heart and deeper love. The letter to the Galatians contains a revolutionary theology of liberation. Sin divides, faith unites. We should so prize our unity in Christ that we do away in practice with all racial, religious, social and sexual inequalities in the company of the baptized now, not only in the coming kingdom. We the Church must be converted if we are to live out to the full our profession of faith in Jesus the Lord.

What does it mean to travel with Jesus toward heaven? It means that we must follow him as he resolutely takes the road to Jerusalem and the passion. This journey is not be graced with self-serving miracles or special preferment (as James and John expected). Lack of hospitality and rejection along the way, and a precarious life without human security, were the lot of Jesus on this earth. There is no time to waste on the road to God; we must be willing to give up everything in order to achieve our goal. Even human ties must take second place to the work of spreading the Good News. The poverty of Spirit demanded of the disciple and apostle requires a break with the past and the fixing of our hearts on Christ for life. Jesus demands a more unconditional response to his invitation than that given by Elisha in the first reading, who is called by Elijah from his daily work. Christ has liberated us from the law, St. Paul writes to the Galatians, to free us for selfless service to one another. The Spirit will guide us in our loving service, by a way which is above the law because it is the way of love.
