Jesus alone cannot complete the mission given him by the Father. Others must go ahead to prepare the way, still others praying God to send workers for the harvest which waits. Jesus sends out seventy-two disciples, symbolic of the nations of the world, with instructions for their great mission: to go

defenceless, without possessions, not wasting time because the hour is urgent. They must be satisfied with whatever hospitality is offered. Those who are impenitent will know God's judgment. Jesus warns his disciples not to rejoice in the power they have through his name, but in the salvation which is promised to them also. In the first reading God's maternal love and comfort for us exiles returning home is figured in the image of Jerusalem, the mother-city. Saint Paul concludes his letter to the Galatians with a key text for any apostle: we can be proud only of the cross of Christ. Suffering endured for the gospel unites us with Jesus, who saved us through the cross. In Christ's cross we find our true comfort; here our apostolate to the world is made fruitful and the harvest gathered in for God.



15th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - C

There is one commandment: to love God wholeheartedly, and our neighbor as ourselves. But who is our neighbor? Jesus answers the question of the lawyer, who was seeking to save face, by telling a story in which the question is rephrased. "To whom am I neighbor?" emphasizes, not legalistic concern for personal salvation, but selfless love for everyone. Jesus' parable condemns the rigid caste whose profession was the service of God but who did not love a suffering human being. Ironically, the one who proved to be loving was a hated heretic – considered sinful – the Samaritan. We cannot put limits on our definition of the neighbor, but must show Jesus' compassion to all classes of people who suffer injustice and deprivation. In today's first reading, Moses insists that the law of God requires more than external observance; as a covenant inscribed on our hearts, it invites a personal relationship of love. The Colossians hymn glorifying Christ presents Jesus as the head of all creation who won salvation for us through his death. Christ's own love is our supreme example and ideal as we keep God's command to love.


