



MOST HOLY TRINITY - A

Who is God? What does knowing him mean for us? When God revealed his name to Moses, he initiated a personal relationship of love with his people. To tell one's name is to reveal one's identity. God uses the language of mother-love to describe his tenderness, patience, and fidelity. Given such a relationship, even sinful people can beg to be adopted as God's

children. John's three verses sum up the entire gospel: God loved us so much that he sent his Son. To believe in Jesus is to know God; to reject Jesus is to refuse life. Paul's letter calls us to the shared joy which is the mark of Christians. God's children mirror his love, peace and unity; by helping one another we become more like God. Our 'kiss' of peace during the Eucharist expresses our love. Paul's concluding blessing calls on God as source of our love, Jesus the Crucified who has manifested God's love for us, and the indwelling Spirit who enables us to love God and each other. The life of the Trinity is model and source for our Christian lives.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, is now and ever shall be. Amen.

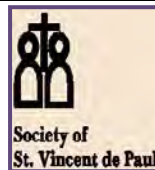
