Rocks are everywhere, in every shape and size. The smallest ones sneak inside your shoe and cause you to hobble along the road, while the largest ones seem to have no beginning or end. In many parts of North America one can admire awesome mountain ranges, but even small or sizable rocks have their charm. Though rocks seem solid, impenetrable, immovable and unchanging, they actually do change because of the interaction between their geological make-up and the effect of the environment. The stone mason can tell you which stones can be cut for a building foundation; which will make a great seawall; which must be placed very carefully to allow for shifting, cracking and erosion; and which should just be left alone. The gospel today tells us of Jesus' promise to build his church on Peter – the Rock – the one who confesses that Christ is the Son of the Living God. "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven," Jesus says in response to Peter's assertion of faith. Like the stone mason, Christ forms and shapes Peter to be the foundation for his body, the Church, which is sustained by the Spirit of the Living God to fulfill the mission of bringing the Good News of salvation to our world. Some rock indeed!



14th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - A

Today's liturgy invites us to become intimate friends with Jesus and the Father. Christ teaches God's wisdom, which reverses human values; to accept it we must be people of simplicity, the *little children* of the gospel. Like children, we can learn about the Father only from the Son, for we cannot hope to know God on the basis of human reasoning. Jesus invites to his school those who will listen to a meek and gentle teacher. The content of his teaching is his own life, held up as a pattern for discipleship. Because he does not ask of others what he himself has not experienced, his yoke is easy and made light by love. That Jesus lived what he preached is apparent in his entry into Jerusalem. There simple people hailed a man without worldly prestige, fulfilling Zachariah's prophecy about a peace-bringing Messiah who would be humble even in triumph. How can we accept this upsetting of our value system? St. Paul assures us that the Spirit forms us into new people, giving us the mind of Christ Jesus.
