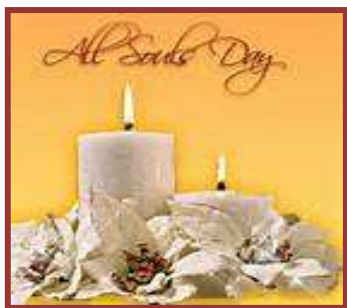




**ALL SOULS DAY**

Death can awaken feelings that are powerful and compelling. The experience of death can so fully envelop a person that it's impossible to imagine a greater life-altering experience.



On All Souls' Day we are faced with the mystery of death and reminded of the promise of eternal life. The first reading acknowledges the complexities of life. Sometimes, when we know loss, our soul feels bereft of peace, confused, overwhelmed. As we learn in Lamentations, the steadfast love of God sustains those who stay with the ups and downs of life's mysteries, and who wait on God's mercy. They express gratitude for God's compassionate love.

In Matthew's gospel, Jesus welcomes the saddened, down-trodden and disturbed. He welcomes all who labour to walk with, learn from and rest with him, and to find peace. Accepting the yoke of Jesus, especially when someone close to us dies, means that we let Jesus be the feet that walk with us, the hands that carry us, the words that comfort and encourage us.

On All Soul's Day we ask God for mercy on those who have died. We pray for an ever deeper and abiding awareness of the steadfast love of God expressed through Jesus Christ. God's love made known in the Risen Christ is reason for our hope.
