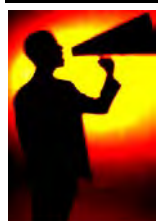




26th SUN IN ORDINARY TIME - B

The Church cannot claim to have exclusive rights on Jesus Christ! In the gospel, Jesus rebukes his disciples for intolerance. God's work will not be limited to exclusive circles and established channels. Others too are graced; do we try to limit their effectiveness and monopolize the work of Christ? We have no reason to be jealous, for God will reward anyone who aids Jesus' followers. As there must be no power struggles, so we must not scandalize the unrestricted. In everything we do, the work of Christ should take precedence over our personal views and position. Eternal life with Christ is of such great value that we must avoid sin or scandal at any cost. Are we as large-hearted as Moses, who in the first reading rebukes those envious of God's gifts and wishes that all were graced with God's Spirit? The letter of James deals with another kind of hoarding: overconsumption. Human exploitation and injustice by the wealthy of this world cry out to the Just One, who will render judgment on the last day.
