



13<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - A



Living our Christian commitment is never an easy task. It is an ongoing invitation to answer to the 'great commission' that is given to all the baptized. This weekend's gospel reading presents us with the discourse that occurs after Jesus calls each of his disciples by name, these very ordinary people who had commonplace lives marked by birth, growing up, marriage, children, subsistence work and death, much like our own hidden lives. Jesus calls these people out of their everyday existence to a spectacular purpose: working with him to bring about the kingdom of justice, peace and love in this world and to prepare for the next. In calling them, in calling us through the baptism that Paul refers to, Jesus affords each of us a dignity, a purpose and a value unique to our gifts and capacities. For some of us, we may be called to welcome the stranger, as the Shunammite woman did, to listen with patience and openness to the prophets in our midst, no matter how unwelcome their message might be. Or maybe we are simply called to respond to someone's need for a cold cup of water to offset the heat of a blazing July sun.



### 14<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - A

This liturgy invites us to become intimate friends with Jesus and the Father. Christ teaches God's wisdom, which reverses human values; to accept it we must be people of simplicity, the *little children* of the gospel. Like children, we can learn about the Father only from the Son, for we cannot hope to know God on the basis of human reasoning. Jesus invites to his school those who will listen to a meek and gentle teacher. The content of his teaching is his own life, held up as a pattern for discipleship. Because he does not ask of others what he himself has not experienced, his yoke is easy and made light by love. That Jesus lived what he preached is apparent in his entry into Jerusalem. There simple people hailed a man without worldly prestige, fulfilling Zachariah's prophecy about a peace-bringing Messiah who would be humble even in triumph. How can we accept this upsetting of our value system? St. Paul assures us that the Spirit forms us into new people, giving us the mind of Christ Jesus.
